 \Box O 1 Corinthians 10:31 ESV, So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.

□O 1 Corinthians 6:20 ESV, For you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body.

 \Box O 1Corinthians 9:24 NIV, Do you not know that in a race all the runners run, but only one gets the prize? Run in such a way as to get the prize.

□O Romans 12:1 NIV, Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship.

 \Box O Philippians 1:20 ESV, As it is my eager expectation and hope that I will not be at all ashamed, but that with full courage now as always Christ will be honored in my body, whether by life or by death.

 \Box O Galatians 2:20 KJV, I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

 \Box O 2 Corinthians 5:17 KJV, Therefore if any man be in Christ , he is a new creature: old things have passed away; behold, all things are become new.

□ O Romans 8:11 MSG, It stands to reason then, doesn't it, that if the alive-and-present God who raised Jesus from the dead moves into your life, he'll do the same thing in you that he did in Jesus, bringing you alive to himself? When God lives and breathes in you (and he does, as surely as he did in Jesus), you are delivered from that dead life. With his Spirit living in you, your body will be as alive as Christ's!

 \Box O Galatians 5:1 NIV, It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery.

 \Box O Galatians 5:13 NIV, You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, serve one another humbly in love.

 \Box O I Corinthians 10:23 NIV, Everything is permissible --but not everything is beneficial. Everything is permissible --but not everything is constructive.

□O Ezekiel 18:32 MSG, I'll judge each of you according to the way you live, so turn around! Turn your backs on rebellious living so that your sin won't drag you down. Clean house. No more rebellions, please. Get a new heart! Why would you choose to die, Isreal? I take no pleasure in anyone's death. Make a clean break. Live!

 \Box O Philippians 3:19 ESV, Their end is destruction, their god is their belly, and they glory in their shame, with minds set on earthly things.

 \Box O Ecclesiastes 10:17 ESV, Happy are you, O land, when your king is the son of the nobility, and your princes feast at the proper time, for strength, and not for drunkenness!

□O Proverbs 23:2 NIV, And put a knife to your throat if you are given to gluttony.

 \Box O Proverbs 25:28 ESV, A man without self-control is like a city broken into and left without walls.

□O Haggai 1:6-9 ESV, You have sown much, and harvested little. You eat, but you never have enough; you drink, but you never have your fill. You clothe yourselves, but no one is warm. And he who earns wages does so to put them into a bag with holes. "Thus says the Lord of hosts: Consider your ways. Go up to the hills and bring wood and build the house, that I may take pleasure in it and that I may be glorified, says the Lord. You looked for much, and behold, it came to little. And when you brought it home, I blew it away. Why? declares the Lord of hosts. Because of my house that lies in ruins, while each of you busies himself with his own house.

 \Box O Matthew 7:1-2 NIV, Do not judge so that you will not be judged. For in the way you judge, you will be judged; and by your standard of measure, it will be measured to you...

□O Romans 14:1-4 ESV, As for the one who is weak in faith, welcome him, but not to quarrel over opinions. One person believes he may eat anything, while the weak person eats only vegetables. Let not the one who eats despise the one who abstains, and let not the one who abstains pass judgment on the one who eats, for God has welcomed him. Who are you to pass judgment on the servant of another? It is before his own master that he stands or falls. And he will be upheld, for the Lord is able to make him stand.

 \Box O Romans 14:23 ESV, But whoever has doubts is condemned if he eats, because the eating is not from faith. For whatever does not proceed from faith is sin.

 \Box O Psalms 100:3 ESV, Know that the Lord, he is God! It is he who made us, and we are his; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture.

 \Box O Hosea 11:4 ESV, I led them with cords of kindness, with the bands of love, and I became to them as one who eases the yoke on their jaws, and I bent down to them and fed them.

 \Box O Proverbs 4:20-23 ESV, My son, be attentive to my words; incline your ear to my sayings. Let them not escape from your sight; keep them within your heart. For they are life to those who find them, and healing to all their flesh. Keep your heart with all vigilance, for from it flow the springs of life.

□O Psalms 139:13-18 ESV, For you formed my inward parts; you knitted me together in my mother's womb. I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderful are your works; my soul knows it very well. My frame was not hidden from you, when I was being made in secret, intricately woven in the depths of the earth. Your eyes saw my unformed substance; in your book were written, every one of them, the days that were formed for me, when as yet there was none of them. How precious to me are your thoughts, O God! How vast is the sum of them!

□O Hosea 4:6 NIV, My people are destroyed from a lack of knowledge.

 \Box O Proverbs 1:7 ESV, The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge; fools despise wisdom and instruction.

 \Box O Psalms 119:11 ESV, I have stored up your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you.

 \Box O Matthew 6:33 ESV, But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you.

□ O Ephesians 6:10-13 NIV, Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand.

 \Box O 2 Corinthians 10:4-5 NIV, The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds. We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ.
